

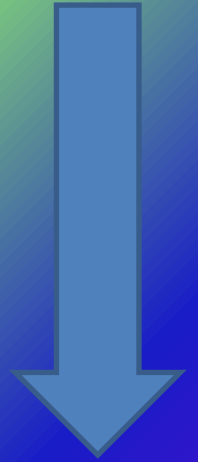
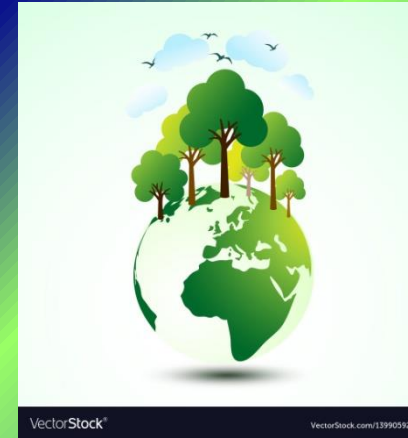

What MUST we do?

In order to keep our planet clean and healthy we must try and use biodegradable materials like:

- Cardboard packaging
- ECO-friendly ink
- Reuse rainwater
- Turn off lights whenever possible
- More solar panels on buildings

- Use less paper
- Sustainable and biodegradable wipes
- Use less public transport-walk or cycle instead



MATERIALS:

Reusable cardboard:

By using recycled cardboard we can ensure that we reduce the amount of waste that ends up in landfill sites. These are known to be extremely harmful to the local area through air and water pollution. So by recycling more cardboard, less ends up in landfill which decreases the damaging effects.

Alternatives to plastic:

Bamboo - It is a fast-growing renewable resource that is lightweight, durable and compostable that can replace plastic.

Seaweed - It is totally natural, completely biodegradable and can be used to make a range of packaging, which is sustainable.

Wood - It is a renewable resource from sustainably-managed forests, which can replace plastic when creating household items such as, kitchen utensils and furniture.

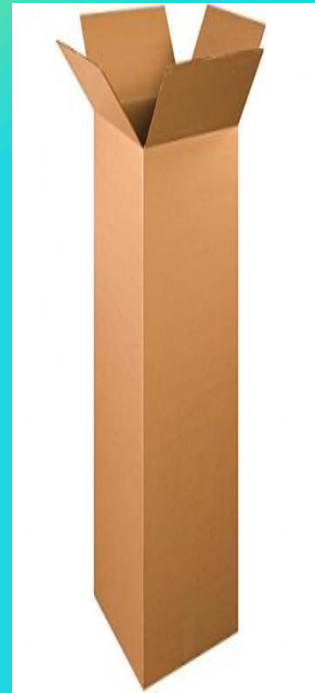
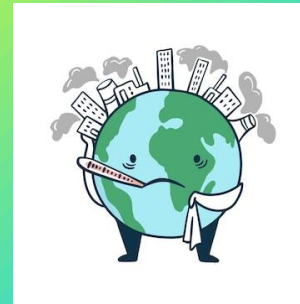

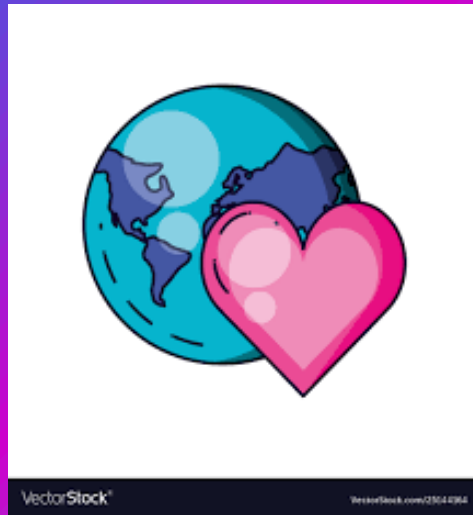
